MEETING MINUTES

AHEC Emergency Preparedness (Eric Leath)

■ EP will host another Heartsaver First Aid/CPR/AED course on Feb. 24. It's half full right now, so please promote it: www.ahec.edu/first-aid-registration.



- EP will host the next Spotlight on Preparedness sometime after Spring Break; the topic will be Citizen Trauma training.
- Eric reported that he's now working on the COOP for AHEC—will be his primary focus this year.

Auraria Campus Police Department (Chief Mike Phibbs)

- Denver has had a lot of protest activity with the current political climate:
 - o Inauguration Day (January 20th) protest affected safety on campus (jumping on cars, using road flares), so campus was put on lockdown.
 - o The Women's March on Denver was peaceful and produced no safety issues.
 - o Last weekend, there was a Muslim neighbor rally which also produced no safety problems.
 - o There's a pro-choice rally this weekend.
 - Next weekend there will be a "Not My President's Day" march, which might draw the same crowd as the Inauguration Day march.
 - Students marched on campus this week in response to the new Secretary of Education.
 ACPD monitored and followed, letting folks exercise their first amendment.
- Immigration issue is causing some concern. ACPD is talking to departments/concerned people to let them know what the ACPD's position is, which is they don't enforce anything related to immigration issues.
- A Rave notification went out after the RTD officer was shot given that the activity was close to campus. He was found a block and a half from campus.
- The ACPD responded to Campus Village earlier this week to help a student who attempted suicide.

CriticalArc Demo (Doug Abraham, Chief of Police, University of Colorado Denver-Anschutz)

- Chief Abraham provided a demo of a web-based software system called CriticalArc, which allows
 users to download an app to be tracked for safety and security purposes.
- It allows the PD to select geofences on any of their campuses to track where users are located.
 Users can submit a panic alert to notify the PD of any safety issues.
- Anschutz is utilizing it in their Outpatient Psych Unit right now. They installed bluetooth devices throughout the work unit, so if a user hits "emergency/panic" on the phone app, it shows up as an emergency on the website.



- It's visible on an iphone (via Omniguard API) and also opens up a line of communication so conversation can be heard.
- One negative is it's a drain on a user's phone battery.
- Useful for class trips, as students/faculty can find one another.
- There's an annual charge for it; not based on users, frequency, etc.
 - o They're not paying for it yet because they're test users.
- Helps to communicate building-specific issues.
- Planning to put it in high-risk locations (OMBUDS, Bursar's Office, etc.).
- Chief Phibbs said it might be useful as a solution for communicating with Campus Village.
