



Student Example: Before, During, and After Note Taking Strategy

Students learn in different ways, yet one thing in common to successful learners is note taking! This document demonstrates how a student may apply Before, During, and After strategies.

Before and During Example

When writing notes, add course name, title, and date at the top of the page. Then, draw a T-chart. During class use the 2/3 section for notes and the 1/3 section for questions and comments. Use annotations such as numbering, abbreviations, or symbols in your notes. See below:
