

DEGREE TYPES


- **AA** The Associate of Arts degree is a learning foundation in communications, social sciences, arts or humanities.
- **AS** The Associate of Science degree is granted after completion of a mathematics or science curriculum.
- **AGS** The Associate in General Studies prepares you with core, general education courses in preparation for transfer to all state 4-year colleges and universities.
- **AAS** The Associate in Applied Sciences prepares you for entry-level employment in a given occupation or upgrades employable skills. Some courses may transfer.

Plan of Study: You will earn a general AA or AS degree that will be transferrable to a Colorado fouryear state college. However, your plan of study will not be designated on your transcript or diploma. See college catalog for more information.

- * Denotes a "Degree with Designation" (DWD) that has a Statewide Transfer Degree Plan in place and is fully transferrable in its entirety into any Colorado public four-year program. DWD's are awarded with a specific program designation on your transcript and diploma.
- ** A **transfer agreement** has been reached with specific four-year institutions for this degree. See college catalog for more information.

COLORADO & THE CITY OF DENVER

Community College of Denver is located in a medium-sized metropolitan area, big enough to have all the amenities, but small enough for you to quickly feel comfortable. THE CITY OF DENVER

- Located on high plains at the eastern base of the Rocky Mountains, Denver is centrally located on what is known as the Front Range.
- The sun shines over 300 days a year and the unusually mild climate makes
 Denver an outdoor playground.
- Denver offers so much to do!
 Cultural activities, including numerous museums, gardens, the opera and symphony, are readily available in Denver.
- Professional sports teams, including the Denver Broncos, Colorado Rockies, Colorado Avalanche, Colorado Rapids and the Denver Nuggets, offer activities for the sports enthusiast.
- In 2010, the Denver metro area reached a population of 2.9 million. Roughly 32 percent of the core city population is Latino, 12 percent African-American, three percent Asian and one percent Native American.
- There are eight major four-year universities and colleges located within a 45-mile radius of CCD. These include the Universities of Colorado at Boulder and Denver, Metropolitan State University of Denver, University of Northern Colorado, University of Denver, Colorado State University, Colorado School of Mines.
- City wide bus service and light rail commuter trains make getting around the city easy.

THE STATE OF COLORADO

- Colorado is one of the most beautiful states in the U.S. We have ten national parks and monuments,
 42 state parks, thousands of acres of national forest, all perfect for mountain biking or hiking!
- Winter weather only gives Colorado more options of things to do. There are more than 20 ski resorts in the state, offering skiing, snowboarding, dogsledding, snowshoeing and ice skating ... all include crisp winter air, and fluffy snow in the mile-high sunshine.
- Colorado is centrally located within the U.S., opening you up to lots of travel options within America. The Grand Canyon, Las Vegas and Chicago are just a few options within a day's drive. Denver also has an international airport, so there are a lot of direct flights to overseas locations.
